Who can take part?

To take part you must have had a stroke between the ages of 18-65years. And, you must have lived or be currently living with your parent(s) following a stroke. We are looking for stroke survivors and their parent(s) to take part.

What is the purpose of the study?

Research suggests that family factors are important in the recovery from stroke. As a Trainee Clinical Psychologist, I am interested in the impact of stroke on families.
